Course outline: This course is designed to enable you to produce the best quality prints possible from your digital files and to build confidence in best practice use of Photoshop. You will establish the principles of digital darkroom techniques and the ground rules of colour management.

Tutor presentation and hands-on examples of top-quality prints as a target to aim for. Produce a 16"x12" c-type print from one of your original files before working on it.

Colour managing your workstation

Delegates perform monitor calibration, Photoshop colour settings and printer profiles

12:00 Preparing your files for print out (resolution, pixel dimensions, interpolation, print preview)

2x10 min tutor presentation of underpinning knowledge

Delegates work on sample files to correct contrast, colour balance and colour saturation.

Delegates practice hands-on printing with guidance

13:45 Preview, prediction and proofing

10 min tutor presentation of underpinning knowledge

Gamut, proof colours, using profiles

15:00 Creative handprinting techniques

10 min tutor presentation of underpinning knowledge

Delegates work on sample files to burn-in

Delegates practice hands-on printing with guidance.

Produce a 16"x12" c-type print of the file that has been worked on and improved.
